Gardening Class in Term 2, 2024

Gardening Activities are important to teach everybody how to grow food and to provide extra food to the school meals.



In public schools children are studying for the whole day without something to eat. We provide a meal for every child who is with us.

Dates and Figures School Term April to August 24

We have just closed our second term today August 23rd 2024. The term has been very productive and full of positive energy.

Our school calendar has 3 terms (semesters) in a year and the third term is always the promotional term for the next class or level. The primary school consists of 7 classes (Primary 1 to Primary 7). After Primary 7 the kids move on to a secondary level.

In primary school, children study Mathematics, English, Social studies, and Science. Every year in November, Primary 7 students sit for a national exam called the Primary Leaving Examination (PLE).

Every term has supports activities like the following:

Term 1

Athletics

Term 2

Music, dance and drama

Term 3

Ball games like football, volleyball, basketball and others

Status Registration

The School is intermediarly registered until the end of 2024. Registration means that we are accepted as a school with standards according to the Ministry of

Education in Uganda. We need to be registered in order to run the school.

There are certain requirements and we are in the process of meeting those in order to get a final registration. As this is a temporary first step we achieved, we have to renew it in 2025. Until then we need to be able to show that we are further on a good path to success:

The registrar wanted good classrooms and lavatories, which we achieved in 2023 and 2024. It was important for us to have the lavatories for sanitary reasons and the situation is so much better for everybody now. The new building, that succeeds the termite eaten old block is a solid improvement in the eyes of the registration officials. We are endlessly thankful for this help from you, our friends in Germany, in 2023 and 2024.

What the registration now additionally wants for the next phase is:

A Gate which will cost UGX 8.500.000 (~2.050 €)

Plastering, fitting (windows & door) and painting of the existing main block at UGX 25.000.000 (~6.032 €)

Achivements

In 2023 and 2024, we were delighted to have new beautiful lavatories, a plastered office, two classroom blocks, a food store, and a kitchen. All of which was donated by you. We had a local building team and everybody was delighted to help.



Lavatories with two different sections one for girls and one for boys. The girls section includes showers which is important for womens hygiene.



On the left the two classroom block with two classrooms for primary 1st and 2nd. On the right corner the kitchen and the storage.

In 2022 we build a teachers office. It is not plastered and painted yet. As is the “old” school block with five additional classrooms. Making them clean, bright and pretty is a further step for registration. So the Registrar sees the progress in professionalism which is happening at our school through our solidary helpers from Germany.
